SUBJECT: Waiver of Tax Penalty and Interest

Please be advised that, in response to impacts related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Isle of Wight County Board of Supervisors, at its regular meeting on April 30, 2020, adopted an amendment to the County's tax ordinance with the following provisions: late payments of personal property taxes and real estate taxes due between April 16, 2020 - August 3, 2020 will not be assessed penalty or interest.

Late payments of food and beverage taxes due in April 2020 and May 2020 will not be assessed penalty or interest until 60 days after their due date. Late payments of food and beverage taxes due in June 2020 will not be assessed penalty or interest if paid by August 3, 2020. Timely filing of all reports required under this Article is still required.

The amendment further provides that any payment of the aforementioned taxes after August 3, 2020 may incur a late payment penalty and interest upon such payment which would begin accruing on August 4, 2020.
